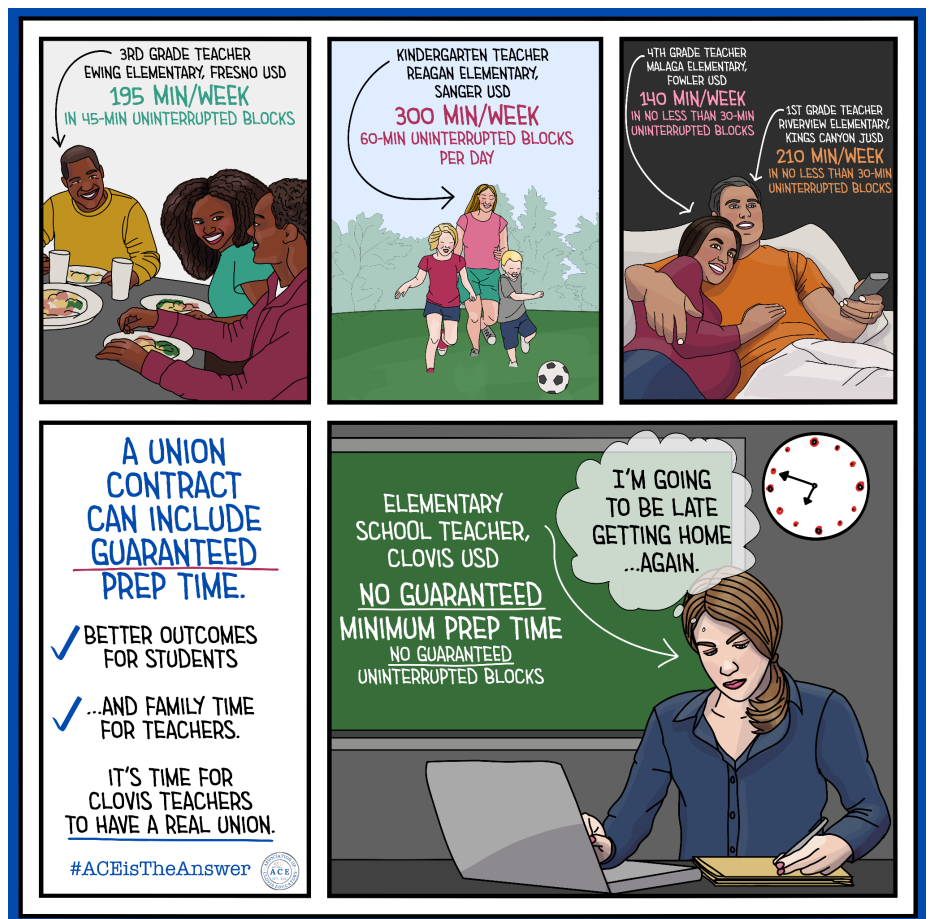
Prep Time

One of the biggest frustrations we experience as Clovis educators (especially elementary teachers) is about prep time. Clovis USD has guidelines about prep time – before and after the bell, during music, and one early-release Wednesday a month – **but, without a union contract, it's not legally binding.**

In essence, **Clovis educators have no guarantee** that we'll have the prep time – paid, uninterrupted, and during work hours – that we need to create quality lesson plans, grade work, confer with peers, and take care of all the other million little things we do for our kids.

The other casualty of inconsistent prep time is our own wellbeing – through missing out on family time, going to the doctor after school, or simply being able to go home at the end of the day to recharge.

By unionizing, classroom teachers can collectively bargain prep time minimums – including uninterrupted blocks per day – and a way to make sure it is followed. So, what does a world with a union contract look like? Take a look at neighboring districts:

On Monday, 10/17, the ACE Psychologists and MHSP's Bargaining team met with the District. The discussion included our counter-proposals on:

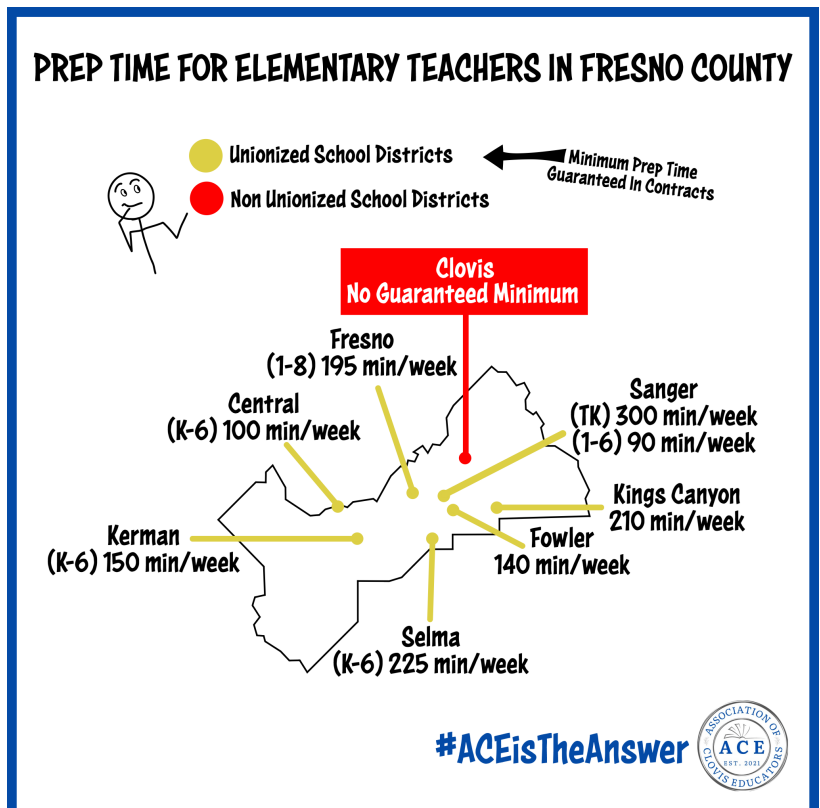
- **EVALUATIONS:** We want to ensure that Improvement Plans should include measurable goals, and that we are able to have conversations with those completing our evaluations.
- **MANAGEMENT RIGHTS:** We want to ensure that, while management has the right to make certain decisions regarding the district, topics that are related to our job are bargained with us.

Given that this is our 13th meeting, we're encouraging the district to pick up the pace – because we believe that our proposals are designed to address our current staffing shortage and maximize the support we can provide to students. Bottom line: CUSD has the resources to invest in the special education and mental health services our students need and deserve.
