Parent-Teacher Conferences this Week


The district shall provide sufficient non-instructional time (minimum days or student non-attendance days) during a teacher's regular duty day to allow all K-8 teachers to schedule parent-teacher conferences. - Central Unified District Union Contract, Page 16

Clovis Unified elementary school teachers are spending many of their waking hours this week meeting with parents. This is important work – and a critical element in ensuring students have the support of multiple adults in their lives. To prepare for these conferences, educators need TIME. This is a subject we've mentioned before, but it's worth highlighting again: guaranteed prep time is something that can be included in a union contract.
