Dollars & Common Sense


Can CUSD afford to address the need for more school psychologists and MHSPs for our students? **In short: yes**.


The <u>proposals</u> presented by the ACE School Psychologist Bargaining Team would substantially increase Psychologist and MHSP staffing – by creating more attractive and sustainable positions via a competitive salary schedule.

Our estimates of the increased costs are between \$3-5 million, depending how it's calculated. What do the District's own documents say about the resources available this year? The CUSD 2022-2023 Fiscal Year Budget (including the 45 day revision reflecting the finalized state budget) showed a \$55 million increase from last year in unrestricted LCFF funding from the state, plus more than \$80 million in net increases to other federal, state, and local sources - some unrestricted, some restricted, and some specifically targeting mental health and special ed - all of which contribute to the District's General Fund revenue. And that's on top of the already substantial Ending Fund Balance - now totalling more than \$166 million; which is far in excess of the Board's policy for maintaining reserves (i.e. \$58 million beyond the requirement of 10% reserves even after removing all non-spendable, restricted, and committed dollars).

In summary, with the largest increase we've ever seen in our budget, how can we say it isn't enough to prioritize support for mental health and Special Education?
